From the Base Treasurer



As I reported at our last month's Base Meeting, I opened up a Savings Account for the Base at Navy Federal Credit Union (NFCU) with \$25K transferred from our PNC Checking account in July. In Sept, I opened a Share Certificate of Deposit for \$5K for 1-Year from those funds in savings. This certificate is earning 4.8% APR with dividends earned reinvested monthly. My intent to \$5K certificates in Dec 2023 , Mar 2024 & Jun 2024.

HRB Currents, October 2023

The end result will be that HRB ends up with (4) \$5K Certificates next year, with one certificate that matures each quarter (Sep 2024). While still maintaining another \$5K liquid in NFCU Share Savings Account.

As I stated last month, Annual Dues are coming due again and you need to have your dues paid by 12/31/23 for the 2024 membership year. Annual dues for National & HRB are as follows: 1 Yr - \$45.00, 3 Yrs - \$127.50, 5-Yrs - \$210.00. I will start sending out dues notices later this month so I can help you get renewed on time.

Message from Immediate Past Base Commander

Shipmates and Esteemed Associates,

Every two years, on the odd numbered years, Hampton Roads Base holds elections to select new leadership, or renew existing leadership. As the most recent past Base Commander still active in HRB, I am the chair of the Nominating Committee. From the Base bylaws: The Nominating Committee shall be an annual committee and shall meet as required to make recommendations to the Base for the filling of elected offices either at the time of regular elections or

when a vacancy of an elected office develops. The Committee shall be chaired by the Immediate Past Base Commander (or most recent Base Commander who is still active in the Base) and members shall be all Past Base Commanders who remain active in regular Base activities. The duties of the Nominating Committee shall include: (1) Soliciting eligible

candidates for Base offices; (2) Reporting the slate of candidates at the Regular Base Meeting preceding the meeting at which officers will be elected; (3) Assist the Base Commander in conducting the election of Base Officers.

At the October base meeting, I will be formally soliciting nominations for elected Base Officers. The positions available for election are: Base Commander, Senior Vice Base Commander, Junior Vice Base Commander, Base Secretary, and Base Treasurer. The duties and responsibilities of these offices are listed in the base bylaws, which can be found on our website by navigating to: <https://www.hrb-ussvi.org/base-operations> and clicking on By-Laws in the right-hand column. While you are at it, I recommend reviewing the duties and responsibilities of all appointed positions as well.

Now is the time for you to get involved in Base Leadership! You don't have to be an elected officer to be involved. You can express your interest to any current member of base leadership, myself included. There are many appointed positions, committees and volunteer positions that can use your help. Those positions are a great way to get involved at the ground floor and work your way up the ranks. Associate members are eligible for elected positions, and Associate members are eligible to vote in base elections.

Currently our Senior Vice Commander and Junior Vice Commander have volunteered for nomination to fleet up to Base Commander and Senior Vice Commander respectively. The current Base Secretary and Base Treasurer have agreed to accept nomination to remain in office for another term. That leaves the Junior Vice Base Commander open to new nominations, but keep in mind that ALL POSITIONS are open to nominees.



We will formally accept nominations at the October meeting. Nominees will be presented to the Base for consideration at the November meeting, with voting to take place at the December meeting. Current practice is that voting is held in-person at the December meeting only. There are no provisions for electronic voting or proxy voting, so if you want to vote, be at the meeting!

Boats Lost in the Month of October

USS O-5 (SS-66)

Lost on October 29, 1923, with the loss of 3 men when rammed and sunk by SS ABABGAREZ off the Panama Canal.

USS S-44 (SS-155)

Lost on October 7, 1943, with the loss of fifty-six men when it was sunk off Paramushiru, Kuriles. S-44 was on her 5th war patrol after attacking a target thought to be a merchant on the surface. S-44 found herself in a losing gun battle with a heavily armed Japanese destroyer. Two men were taken prisoner and survived the war.

USS WAHOO (SS-238)

Lost on October 11, 1943, with the loss of eighty men near La Perouse Strait. Under command of one of the great sub skippers of World War II, LCDR "Mush" Morton, WAHOO was on her 7th war patrol. WAHOO had won a Presidential Unit Citation and ranks 5th in the number of enemy ships sunk. She was lost to depth charges dropped by a Japanese patrol aircraft.

USS DORADO (SS-248)

Lost on October 12, 1943, with the loss of seventy-seven men when she was sunk in the western Atlantic near Cuba. Newly commissioned, she had departed New London and was enroute to Panama. She may have been sunk by a U.S. patrol plane that received faulty instructions regarding bombing restriction areas or a German U-boat that was in the vicinity.

USS SEAWOLF (SS-197)

Lost on October 3, 1944, with the loss of eighty-three officers and men and seventeen US Army troops when she was sunk just north of Moritai by USS ROWELL, a Destroyer Escort (DE). In this tragic error, ROWELL mistook SEAWOLF for a Japanese

submarine that had just sunk another Destroyer (DD). SEAWOLF ranks 7th for enemy ships sunk.

USS ESCOLAR (SS-294)

Lost on October 17, 1944, with the loss of eighty-two men. She was on her 1st war patrol and was most likely lost to a mine somewhere in the Yellow Sea.

USS SHARK II (SS-314)

Lost on October 24, 1944, with the loss of eighty-seven men when she was sunk near Hainan. The second boat to carry this name during World War II, she was on her 3rd war patrol. SHARK was sunk by escorts after attacking and sinking a lone freighter. Compounding the tragedy, it turned out that the freighter had 1,800 U.S. POWs on board.

USS DARTER (SS-227)

Lost on October 24, 1944, when she became grounded on Bombay Shoal off Palawan and was then destroyed to prevent her from falling into enemy hands intact. The entire crew was rescued by USS DACE. Winner of one Navy Unit Commendation, DARTER had sunk a heavy cruiser and damaged another, and went aground while attempting an "end around" on an enemy formation in hopes of getting in an attack on a battleship.

USS TANG (SS-306)

Lost on October 25, 1944, with the loss of seventy-eight men in the Formosa Strait. TANG was on her 5th war patrol. TANG ranks 2nd in the number of ships sunk, 4th in tonnage, and had won two Presidential Unit Citations. During a daring night surface attack, TANG was lost to a circular run by one of her own torpedoes. Nine of the crew were taken prisoner, including CDR O'Kane and five who had gained the surface from her final resting place 180 feet below. All survived the war, and CDR O'Kane was awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor.

United States Navy

Master Chief Vorce joined the U.S. Navy in June 1970. He went to Boot camp in Great Lakes Illinois, then Yeoman “A” School in Bainbridge, Maryland. After graduation from “A” school his first duty station was Naval Administrative Command, Armed Forces Staff College, Norfolk, Virginia.

After his selection to Yeoman Second Class in February 1974, he was transferred to Naval Station Adak, Alaska where he worked as Classified Control Custodian and Operations Yeoman. From Adak, he transferred to Air-Antisubmarine Squadron TWENTY-TWO at NAS Cecil Field, Florida.

In June 1982, he volunteered for and was accepted to the Submarine Force and subsequently transferred as Leading Yeoman Precommissioning Unit USS ATLANTA (SSN 712). During this tour he was selected to Chief Petty Officer.

In July 1985, he was transferred to Commander in Chief, U.S. Atlantic Fleet CTF 84, and Commander in Chief, U.S. Atlantic Command (USCINCLANT) J-36. He made Senior Chief Petty Officer at this time. After another successful tour he was transferred as Leading Yeoman to USS HYMAN RICKOVER (SSN 709) and during this tour he was selected to Master Chief.

In November 1998, he transferred for this twilight tour to NAVHOSP, Jacksonville, Florida as Assistant Department Head for HRD.

Master Chief Vorce was awarded the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Joint Service Commendation Medal (two awards), Navy Commendation Medal (three awards), Joint Service Achievement Medal and Navy Achievement Medal (two awards) and various unit, service and campaign awards.
